

Prompt Payment H1 2026 (January to June)

Introduction

As a responsible business, we recognise the importance of cash flow for the thousands of businesses across our supply chain. Our latest statistics show that we continue to pay 99% of our invoices within 60 days. We have done this by:

- Engaging with our supply chain on correct invoicing procedures and increasing the use of electronic invoicing
- Monthly reporting of blocked invoices to drive greater discipline within the business
- Improved processes to reduce delays due to 2-way matching
- Greater use of technology, including e-invoicing and automated statement matching, to improve process times and dispute resolution.

Situation at Amey

- In H1 2026 we paid 99% of our invoices within 60 days
- It took us on average 22 days to pay our invoices during this time
- In H1 2026 we paid 72% of all invoices within 30 days
- In H1 2026 we paid 95% of invoices to Small UK suppliers within 30 days.
